Dear Friends,

As part of our continuing effort to provide timely research and education materials to the citizens of our State, Family Policy Alliance of New Jersey is pleased to provide you with this impartial and nonpartisan Voter Guide for the 2021 General Election.

In the past, we've heard from citizens across the State who were frustrated over the lack of reliable information about candidates running for elected office. Radio and television ads often present what the candidates want you to hear, but where do you go for information regarding what candidates really think about the issues that matter to you and your family? When candidate positions are not known, the gathering of enough information to make an informed decision can become a burden—sometimes resulting in voter frustration and even apathy.

Family Policy Alliance of New Jersey has committed to providing a public service to the voters of our state by asking candidates what they think about a variety of issues, and then passing this information along to the public.

In compiling this Voter Guide, we mailed candidate questionnaires to all candidates running for New Jersey State Senate and New Jersey Assembly, based on official records obtained from the N.J. Board of Elections as of July 1, 2021. We attempted to personally contact each candidate to encourage his or her participation in the Voter Guide project. The policy positions surveyed are directly

linked to pending or recently approved legislation in the current legislative session including A3000/S3002, A4454/S2781, A4848/S3030, A228/S429, A5597/S3801, A3670, and A3818 and A5802 in the prior 2018-2019 legislative session.

To facilitate processing and printing, we use a standard response grid of “Support,” or “Oppose,” but we also invited candidates to provide additional comments and/or explanations for their answers. If any answers had further explanation, it will be noted at the bottom of each page. When necessary, we used the voting records of incumbents, the specific bills they sponsored that were not voted on by both legislative chambers, and public comments that were accessible.
