Family Policy Alliance (FPA) is seeking candidates for the full-time position of <u>Development Specialist</u>. The primary responsibilities are building and deepening relationships with Mid-Low, Mid-High, and Major ministry partners through telephone, e-mail, social media, snail mail, and, as needed, personal visits, for the purpose of connecting ministry partners' passions with the ministry's funding needs. This role engages ministry partners to express gratitude for their financial support, sustain and grow giving levels, and solicit special gifts aligned with organizational priorities. Additionally, this team member nurtures prospects and new ministry partners, contributes to marketing activities, and secures sponsorships that support the ministry's events and programs.

Position Specifics:

- A mature Christian faith and comfort working with those holding non-Christian faith beliefs or secular beliefs and upholding the second greatest commandment, "Thou shall love they neighbor as thyself."
- Responsibilities:
 - Develops (with leadership) and executes customized plans for relationship building for each assigned current, prospective and lapsed account, including thank you's, increasing giving levels, and soliciting sponsorships.
 Maintains accurate records of ministry partners in the organization's database on an ongoing basis.
 - o Raises funds according to the following minimum annual goals:
 - Year One: Minimally equal to own salary & benefits.
 - Year Three: Minimally equal to 3x own salary & benefits.
 - Years Five and Beyond: Minimally equal to 5x own salary & benefits, and growing year over year in determination with leadership as relationships grow.
 - Looks for opportunities to expand relationships by seeking the ministry partner's involvement in events, introductions to others, hosting home events, sponsoring tables, rallying others, volunteering time.
- Education & Experience: Desired: 3–5 years of experience in donor relations, fundraising, or nonprofit development, with a strong emphasis on cultivating mid-level to major donors. Experience executing digital giving campaigns and utilizing CRM tools to manage donor engagement and track giving performance.
- Technology Skills: Microsoft Office 365, Constituent Relationship Management platform
- Working Hours & Environment: Willingness to work hours that are conducive to the ministry partners. For example, it may be opportune to work early evenings to connect with people by phone, especially those in different time zones. Willingness to occasionally work nights or weekends in support of organizational events or presentations. This position may require occasional travel, such as for visiting ministry partners, attending events or ministry conferences.
